NEB's 4x400 won in 3:46.23.

Troy's Kendrick Ross (5-feet, 8-inches) won the high jump with teammate Cameron Morey (5-feet, 6-inches) second and Kapr (5-feet, 6-inches) third.

Sens won the shot put in 48-feet, 9-inches with teammate Cooper Watkins (36-feet) third. Sens (121-feet, 8-inches) and Kael Millard (116-feet, 2-inches) went 1-2 in the discus for the Trojans as

NEB's Emma Neuber (30-feet, 5-inches) won the shot put with McRoberts (29-feet, 10 3/4-inches) second, and NEB's Cora Franklin (28-feet, 1-inch) third. Franklin (79-feet, 8-inches) was second in the discus with Troy's Ella Law-ton (76-feet, 9-inches) third.

Kitchen (14-feet, 8 1/2-inches) won the long jump with Troy's Parker Lee (14-feet, 5-inches) and NEB's Leah Fries (13-feet, 11-inches) second and third.

VandeMark (29-feet, 3-inches) won the triple jump with Canton's Stella Rockwell (29-feet, 1-inch) second, and Fries (28-feet) third.
